Health Canada recalls **four acetaminophen products for children and infants**

Health Canada has recalled four acetaminophen products for children and infants due to quality concerns with a manufacturer in China that produces acetaminophen as an ingredient for health products.

Prestige Brands, which manufactures the final products, is voluntarily recalling all their affected products as a precaution.

The affected products are:

**Infant's Little Remedies for Fevers - Berry      02385171   80 mg/mL**
